-Must participate in 4 of the 6 shows to qualify for Series Championship Awards. Championship Awards will be awarded in the following divisions: Youth, Open, Youth Walk-Jog, Open Walk-Jog, Walk n Halt, Open Halter, Open Ranch -Judge's decision is final. Any protest, question or comment regarding the conduct of a class must be directed to the show management. Under no circumstances is the judge to be approached.

-Show Management reserves the right to split, combine, cancel or change the location of any class.

-Show management reserves the right to excuse unruly or dangerous horses. No stallions in youth classes.

-Current negative coggins for either 2021 or 2022 for NYS Horses, 2022 for Out of State Horses. Current 2022 rabies vaccination. -No overnight tying to trailers. You will need to present your coggins and rabies papers to the office for verification. Out of State horses must have their 30 day health papers presented for inspection.

-Per NYS vehicle and Traffic Law 1265: No person less than 18 years of age shall ride a horse unless such person is wearing a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute Certified) Equestrian Standard.

-Horses 6 years or older must be shown on a bit; horses 5 years and younger may be shown in either bit, bosal, or snaffle bit –

ONE back number per horse/rider combination for all 3 show weekends. This helps our office staff to keep track of points. If you have a number that you would like to use please let our office staff know. If you do NOT use the same number for all 3 weekend your points maybe not tracked correctly for series awards.

Stalls must be completely cleaned out to the satisfaction of the Stall inspector. \$10 refund will be given to those who have stalls cleaned and inspected.

Ties will be broken by the horse/rider combination receiving the highest placing on the largest class in that division.

**<u>Showmanship</u> the exhibitor will run the pattern once, with their score counting for English and/or Western Division as long as they are entered/paid in each class, regardless of their tack and attire

*Discipline Rail - a class that judges the horse's performance and manners while executing maneuvers not seen in regular pleasure class. Walk/Jog-Trot MAY include turn on the haunches or forehand, sidepass, stop and stand, back on the rail.

Walk/Jog-Trot/Lope-Canter MAY include counter canter/lope, extension of gaits, side pass, turn on the haunches or forehand, lead changes, etc. Unlike Command classes, horses are not eliminated for failure to perform a required maneuver.

**Open Halter and Open Ranch classes will be their own series awards. Open Halter and Open Ranch will NOT be added to Open Division points.

There must be 3 horses shown in 3 class within a division for a weekend Hi Point Award to be given.

** Ranch Horse Division Rules: Will be judged using AQHA Guild lines. NO horse less than 3 years of age are eligible. No horse may cross enter into Open or Youth western pleasure class.

***Walk n Halt may not enter into any other division.

-Walk Jog/Trot may NOT cross enter into lope/canter classes, but may cross enter in Showmanship. Open Walk Jog/Trot is for any age rider. It is intended for inexperienced horses or riders not yet capable of showing at the lope or canter in a group setting. Entries can not cross enter into classes requiring a lope/canter. However, if an experienced rider wants to ride horses in both walk trot and open, they will ride for exhibition only in the walk jog/trot classes. Trainers may ride in Open Walk/Trot classes Exhibition ONLY.

Ride at your own risk. Riders of unruly horses may be asked to leave the show grounds at any time.

Sweepstakes Classes - Entry fee not included in packages. Horse or rider must show in 2 non-sweepstakes classes. Walk Jog Sweepstakes classes are open to any age rider.

Pre-entries will not be held accountable for fees if you are unable to attend the show.
